The intervention envisages various types of support i.e. medical, home assistance for daily activities, home repairs, and cultural activities, thus it will enhance their quality of life and greater independence of PWDs. This kind of therapy is available only in Belgrade and Ivanjica so the action will widespread the therapy on children in Novi Pazar that counts around 7,000 of such potential beneficiaries.
