





hrough the Swiss PRO Programme, the Swiss Government has supported LSGs and CSOs to implement 19 projects in the period from May 2021 to April 2022 aimed at **mitigating COVID-19 consequences in substandard Roma settlements.** Through the implementation of social inclusion policies and practices, the access to public services has been enhanced and the needs have been fulfilled for **over 2,700 citizens.**
